

Root Canal Post Operative Instructions

Here at Dr. Ravi Doctor's office, we care about our patients. We believe in making sure they have more than enough information to be able to take all the necessary precautions in order to make any of our dental procedures feel seamless. That is the reason why we have come up with a list of post-operative instructions to help you.

It is normal to have some discomfort after root canal treatment. This will normally subside after a few days or even a few weeks. Every person and every tooth heals differently.

The discomfort will slowly start to get better. Until then try to eat soft foods and avoid eating on that side of your mouth. This will allow the tooth to recover.

Call our office if you notice any of the following:

- You have sudden swelling or pus drainage
- Fever
- Increased pain or discomfort

Make sure any anti-inflammatory or antibiotic medications given are taken as directed. Not following the regimen can delay the healing process.
